Re: Freelance coaching and private for profit camps

Freelance coaching and hosting of for profit camps benefitting an individual are not sanctioned activities by the Canadian Ski Coaches Federation & Alpine Canada Alpin. Activities listed on a club training plan for the season are to reflect programs being run by the club, its staff & for the members registered in the club. Proceeds from these activities are to benefit the club & not an individual.

Private camps are not sanctioned activities under the Canadian Snowsports Association group commercial general liability policy & as such leave all members including, the coach, at risk if misrepresented. These types of activities are not to be represented as club activities. Club accounting departments are not to be used to manage the proceeds of such camps.

Allowing coaches to use the ACA, CSCF insurance policies for activities outside the club calendar places the policy & its premiums at risk for the entire country. It is not in the best interest of the club, its members & the development of the sport. If coaches wish to host a private camp for profit they may do so outside of the ACA, CSCF insurance coverage. Private operators must secure insurance independently and promote the camp outside of the club.
